Thank you so much for your interest in The NICCE Foundation. I am so grateful and excited to see others getting involved and spreading the word about our mission! This newsletter is meant to keep you informed on our progress and upcoming events that you might be interested in. We are very pleased to announce that our first attempt at fundraising has been a huge success so far! We held an Art Auction & Wine Tasting event in Hoboken, New Jersey on August 28th. There were around 60 people who came to enjoy the night with us. The event turned out to be a lot of fun and we raised about \$2,346 for the foundation. We recently held our second fundraiser, an Art & Silent Auction held at the First Baptist Church of

Woodbridge in Virginia on September 24th. This event was a huge success with about 115 people in attendance and a total of \$9,724 raised for the foundation. We are hoping to possibly make this an annual event in Woodbridge!

After coordinating with our partners in India, we have recently decided to offer sponsorship for the children attending the school we are working on in Yeasom Village, Manipur. There are 19 children that are in need of sponsors. You or someone you know can sponsor a child for \$30 a month, which will cover their school uniforms, textbooks, meals, etc. You will receive a picture and information on your sponsored student, as well as letters they will write to you from time to time. Upcoming Needs

At this point, we need about \$80,000 more in order to complete construction on the entire project in Yeasom Village. This amount will cover the final building costs for the Children's home (housing around 200 children), the teacher's quarters (housing 8 teachers), and the school (which will be able to hold 200-400 students). The school is already in session at a temporary structure where around 40 children are being

taught. The fact that classes are already being held will help to make the transition smoother with the Indian government when the whole Children's Home project is completed.

With that said, please continue to pray for this mission and for our counterparts in India. It is very important that we stay focused on the goal God has set before us.
